

GLOBAL DAY OF PRAYER 2006

On 15 May 2005 more than 200 million Christians from 156 nations in the world united in the first Global Day of Prayer. Through repentance and prayer Christians gathered in different venues to seek God's face in prayer for the transformation of their communities and nations.

Driven by Hab.2:14 "*For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea*", the dream is to mobilise Christians from every single nation in the world to participate in the Global Day of Prayer on 4 June 2006. But, the focus will not only be on a single day of prayer, rather on a process that will establish a lifestyle of prayer.

There is a simple threefold strategy:

1. 10 Days of day-and-night prayer from Ascension Day till the Saturday before Pentecost Sunday.
2. A global day of repentance & prayer on Pentecost Sunday
3. 90 Days of "community blessing"

Youth and children around the globe will also be challenged to be involved on all levels. Boiler Rooms, 30Kd and living the PEACE-plan will be some of the exciting youth initiatives through which the youth can be involved. The Global Day of Prayer will also partner with VIVA Children's Network in 2006, focusing on the Worldwide Day of Prayer for Children at Risk on 4 June.
